### **GENERAL INFORMATION, RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. All entries must be **RECEIVED by July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2017**. All entries must be paid in full before judging starts. Payment will be accepted at show in the Ag Society office before judging starts.
2. Entries are \$3.00 each. Late entries will cost \$0.50 per entry more. Entries will NOT be accepted at ringside.
3. Please make cheques payable to **Vermilion Ag Society**.

4. All entries must include Class Numbers, Breed, Variety and Sex.
5. If you are entering an exhibit which does not have a class listed in this program, please specify on the entry form and classes will be created as necessary.
6. All N.S.F. cheques returned will result in an automatic \$25.00 service charge.
7. Exhibitors are responsible for paying for birds that have been scratched from the show.
8. In making an entry, the exhibitor agrees to be governed by the rules and regulations.
9. As a precaution, exhibitors are **strongly** urged to vaccinate poultry for I.L.T. using the LT-IVAX vaccine.
- 10. If Avian Influenza arrives in Alberta, the show will be cancelled.**
11. All entries must be clean and healthy. The committee reserves the right to reject entries suffering from disease or shown in an unfit condition, and can order the removal of those entries at any time.
12. All entries must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor at least 30 days prior to the date of the show.
13. No one except the officials of the show will be allowed to handle the exhibit without the permission of the owner. Any exhibitor caught tampering with or in any way injuring exhibits of any competitor will be disqualified.
14. The judge shall have power to withhold awards at his/her discretion and will be instructed to the effect that no award is to be given unless the exhibit is worthy. The judge's decision is final.
15. All birds will be judged in the class as written on the entry form.
16. No birds will be shown from flocks which have had an infectious or contagious disease for at least six weeks prior to entry closing date. Exhibitors who make an entry do so with the distinct understanding that they abide by this regulation, and guarantee that their stock has been free from disease for the period stated.
17. You may make substitutions within class provided the class and section remains the same as the original entry.
18. All specimens must be exhibited in their natural condition except for: All Old English Games, Modern Games and American Games Cocks and Cockerels large and bantam must be dubbed.  
- Canada Geese, Mallard Ducks, Wood Duck and Mandarin Ducks can be pinioned.
19. The latest revised American Standard of Perfection and American Bantam Standard shall be the guide in all Poultry Entries judged.
20. Coop-in will be on Friday evening from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. (building will be locked at 9:00 p.m.) and between 8:00 and 10:00 a.m. on Saturday. After birds are unloaded and cooped-in, exhibitors are asked to please park back out in the general parking areas until move-out time.
21. Move-out for exhibitors is 5:00 p.m. on Saturday.
22. All Poultry, Waterfowl, Turkeys, Guinea Fowl and Eggs open and juniors must be caged by 10:00 a.m. Saturday, July 29<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Judging will start at 10:30 a.m. sharp.
23. Prize money will be awarded to Show Champion and Reserve Show Champion, as well as for the Utility Class and Traditional Pen of Three class.

## **NEW - UTILITY CLASS**

New this year, we are pleased to introduce the Utility Class to the Annual Vermilion Fair Poultry Show! The purpose of this class is to showcase **purebred** birds that exhibit exceptional productive traits, and exemplify the statement 'standard type is productive type.' This class is open to all large chickens, ducks, geese and turkeys. All birds entered should be good representatives of their breed and be free from disqualifications as laid out in the APA Standard of Perfection. **No hybrid birds will be accepted.** Breeds will be judged on the productive characteristics for which their breed is known, ie. Leghorns will be judged on egg laying capacity, Cornish on meat production and Plymouth Rocks on a combination of the two. This class is open to all exhibitors, and will run parallel to the open and junior shows. All birds entered in the utility class must also be entered in the open or junior show. Prizes will be awarded for Best Layer, Best Meat, and Best Dual Purpose. **State "Utility" as the class on the entry form.** On your entry form, please indicate the utility class entry below the bird's regular class entry. An additional entry fee of \$3.00 per bird will apply.
